## Common Signs and Symptoms of TOTs

## Physical Appearances of Infant/Toddler

*Difficulty latching*

*Heart-shaped tip of tongue or tongue cupping upon cry*

*Shallow latch*

*Decreased ability to move food in mouth (picky eating)*

*Clicking sound during feeds*

*Open-mouth posture/ Snoring*

*Falls asleep quickly while eating*

*Tented lip*

*Uncoordinated suck*

*Lip calluses/blisters*

*Sore nipples*

*Atypical head shape: Plagiocephaly, Brachycephaly (back of head),*

*Blistering/Bleeding*

*Dolichocephaly (flattening of the sides, head appears longer)*

*Pain while breastfeeding*

*Torticollis/Decreased neck range of motion*

*Low milk supply*

*Red creases in baby's neck*

*Reflux*

*High-arched palate*
